

## Group 2 (Grade VI-VII-VIII) Sample Questions

Primary Skill: Values and Ethics Secondary Skill: Negotiation Skills

Your best friend has stolen a book from the school library. He really wants to keep the book. What would you do?

- (a) You make him return the book and propose that you can gift him that book on his birthday.
- (b) You tell him to return the book to the librarian.
- (c) You strike a bargain with him to not tell anybody but with a promise that he will return the favour.
- (d) You take the book from him and quietly put it back in the library.

## Answer- Option (a)

- (a) <u>Perfect answer.</u> Having stolen the book, returning it will to the librarian is the right thing to do. Gifting him the book will him happy and could also make him realize his mistake.
- (b) **Not a good choice.** That's a correct decision but it may not be sufficient for your friend to return the book.
- (c) **Bad choice.** Landing your friend in trouble with the librarian without a warning could break your friendship.
- (d) **Not the best choice.** This is not a perfect decision as your friend would be sad, and angry at you and may not really learn much from the situation.

Primary Skill: Social Media Secondary Skill: Leadership Skills

If you find out that a fake account of your name and image has been created by someone, what would be your first response?

- (a) Make friends with the person to snoop around their profile, and look for clues about who they are.
- (b) Contact the user and ask them to stop.
- (c) Report it to the website Admin and ask your friends to do the same.
- (d) Report it to the police.

## Answer- Option (c)

- (a) **Bad choice.** That's very wrong decision as you should stay away from such people.
- (b) **Not a good choice.** The user deliberately chose your images and info... hence they are not likely to accommodate your request. So not the most effective decision in this case.
- (c) **Perfect Choice.** Yes, It is the website administrators responsibility to eliminate fraud.
- (d) **Should not be the first choice.** While police could be of help, but it might take a long time to resolve the issue. So not the best decision.
